

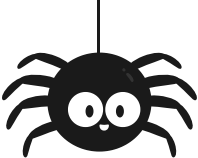

- ☐ A flying animal that comes out at night. _____

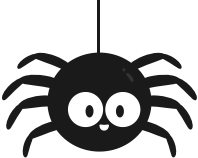
